

Text Help PDF Reader, Enabling Google Classroom Integration

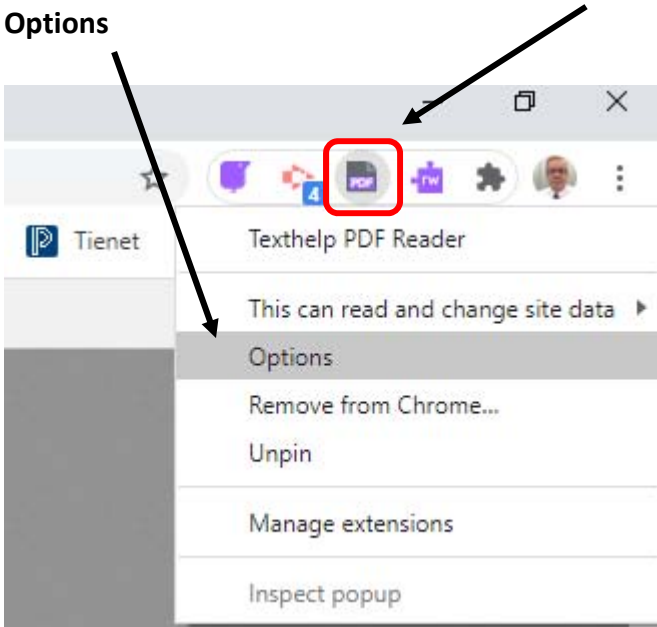
You must have Google Classroom established

AND

TextHelp PDF Reader is installed on teacher and student computers

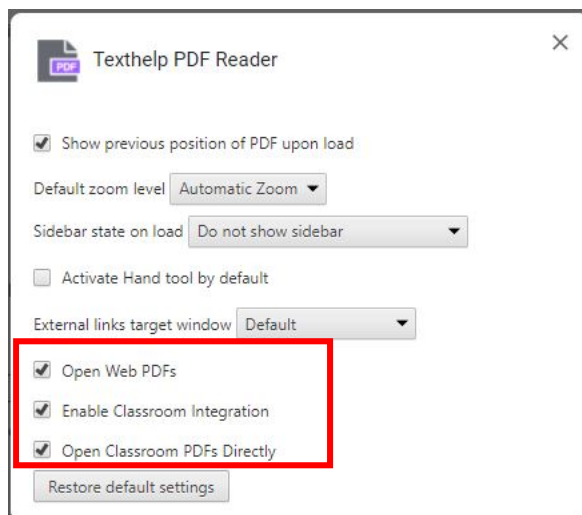
(Teacher and Student setup)

Open a pdf document with Text Help PDF Reader, Navigate to the upper right corner of the screen, to view the installed extensions. Locate the Text Help PDF reader icon, **Right click** to display the context menu. Select **Options**



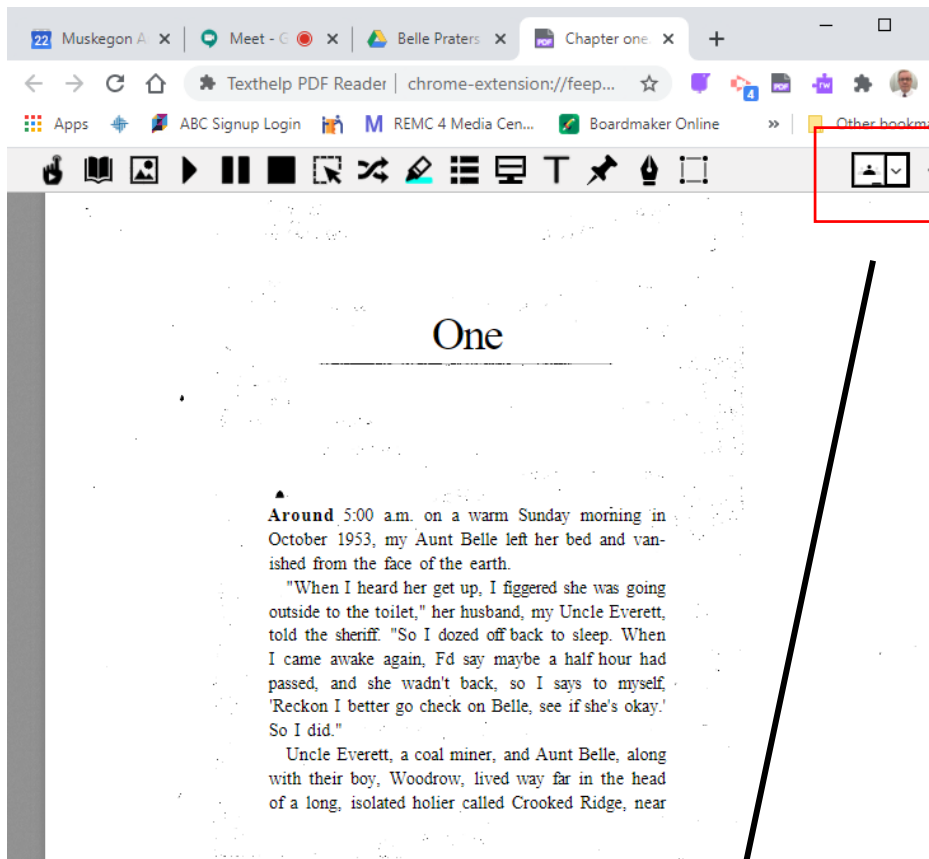
Text Help has very useful **Google Classroom** integration and **PDF** opening options. **You will need to enable these for teachers and students.** This may need to be done for each student account. It only needs to be done once.

When all selections are made, Close the window.



Creating and Distributing Assignments

From Google Drive, Launch a PDF document to be assigned to a Google Classroom.

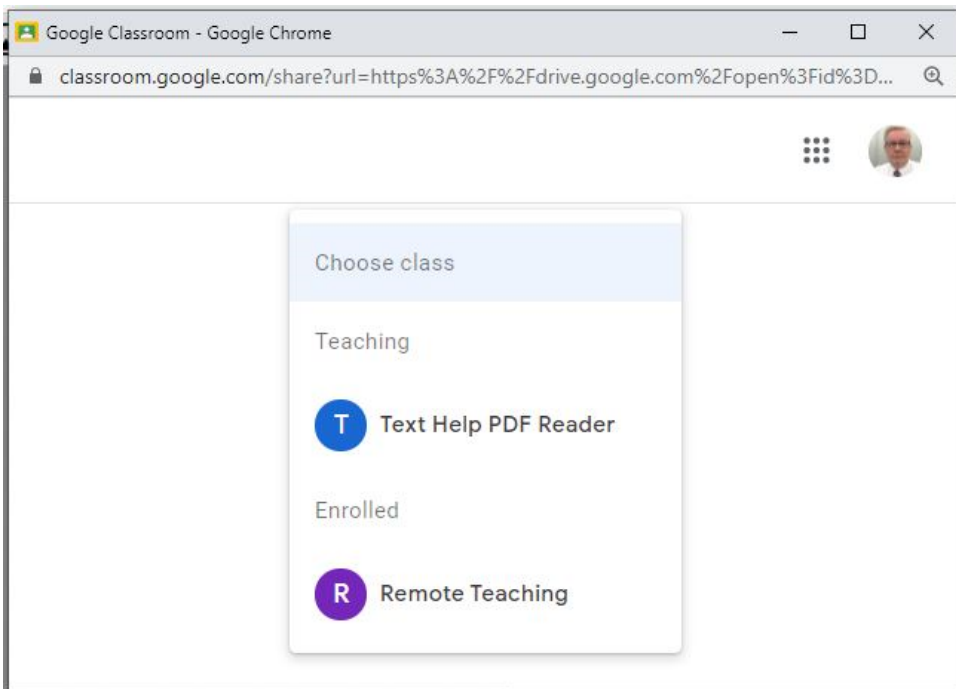
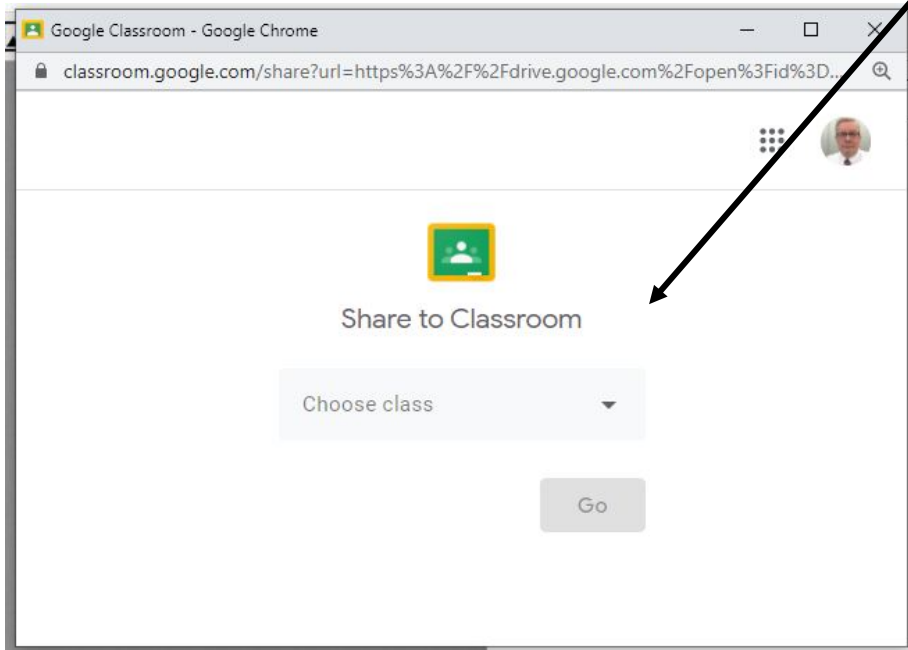
Share annotations with Students

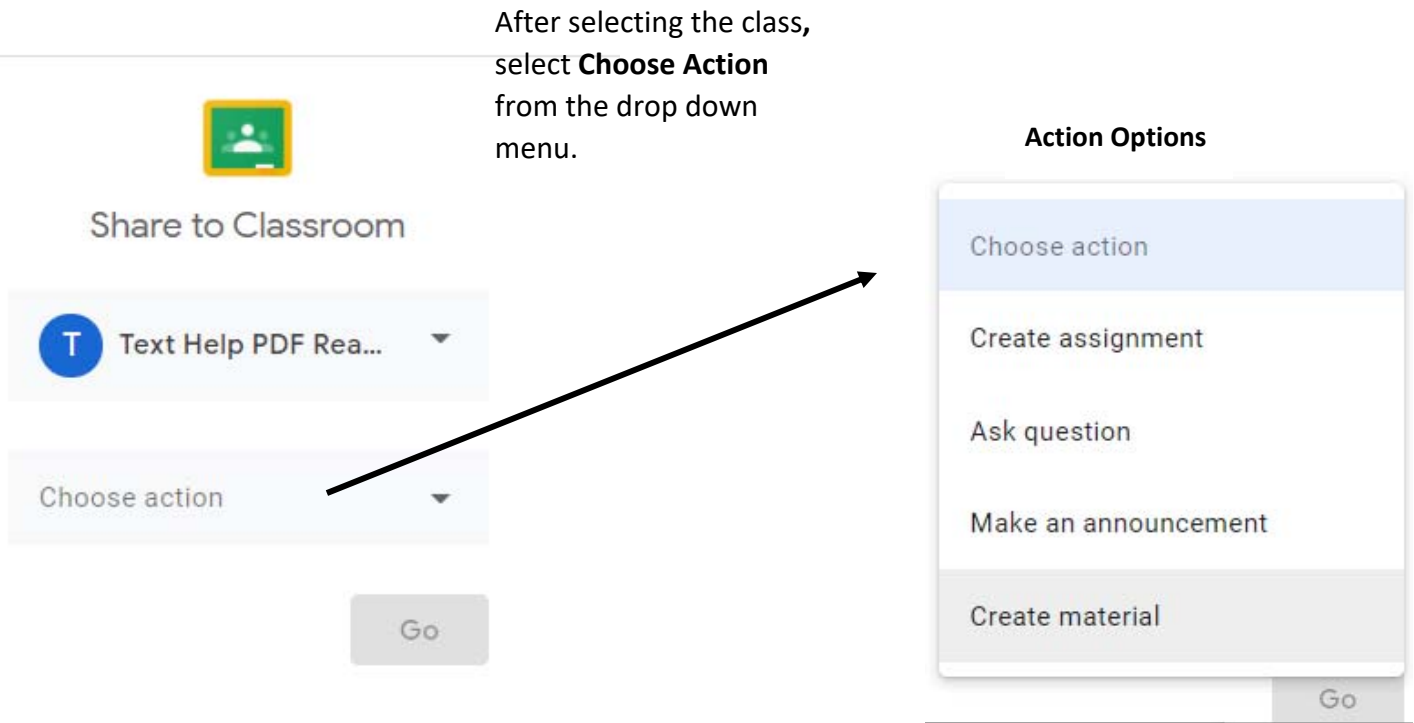
Selecting Link to Google Classroom will start the process in assigning and delivering a PDF document through Google Classroom.

Sharing annotations is important if a teacher decides to highlight passages, pose questions that will direct student learning.

In the following, we will focus on Assigning a PDF through Google Classroom.

Selecting **Link to Google Classroom**, will cause the window (below) to appear. From the **Choose Class** drop down, (All Google Classroom(s) will be displayed.) Select the desired class.





Choose the action, **Create assignment**, then select **Go**

Assignment window

Enter the **Title** of the Assignment, any **instructions** needed, necessary points, due date, and topic, etc.

Because a student might annotate or comment in the PDF, **Make a copy for each student**.

When finished Select **Assign**.
